SEASONAL TRUCK PERMIT AT LEGAL WEIGHTS ON COUNTY ROADS DURING SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS FOR NONEMERGENCY PUBLIC UTILITY WORK

As authorized agent, I (we) hereby request permission to travel with the following public utility company vehicle or vehicle combination on the roads under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission and attest that the vehicle or vehicle combination does not exceed the legal maximum axle and wheel loadings within the county.

APPROVAL BY THE ROAD COMMISSION FOR THE PERMIT REQUESTED FOR THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANY VEHICLE OR VEHICLE IN COMBINATION ON THIS APPLICATION CONSTITUTES A PERMIT IN COMPLIANCE WITH MCLA §257.722 UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS:

- Applicant shall provide notification to the Road Commission, using a notification application provided by the Road Commission, when requesting access to operate on restricted roads. Applicant shall provide notification to the Road Commission, via facsimile or electronically, not later than 24 hours before the time of intended travel. If the Road Commission determines that the condition of a particular road under its jurisdiction makes it unusable the Road Commission may deny access to all or any part of the road. The denial shall be made and communicated via facsimile or electronically to the Applicant within 24 hours after receiving notification that the public utility intends to perform nonemergency work that requires use of that road. Any notification that is not disapproved within 24 hours after the notice is received by the Road Commission is considered approved.
- Travel on seasonally restricted roads during weight restrictions will be minimized and only utilized when necessary to perform work using the public utility vehicle or vehicle configuration. Unrestricted roads shall be used for travel when available and for routine travel.
- Permits are automatically invalidated by the violation of any of the conditions specified by the terms of the permit or by false information given on the application. Failure to comply with the conditions of this permit shall be just cause for the immediate suspension or revocation of any or all permits and the operator and/or owner of the vehicle subject to appropriate legal action.
- The vehicle covered by this permit shall not exceed 35 M.P.H. at any time.
- The movement shall not impede other traffic in an unreasonable manner and at no time shall traffic be blocked from use of the highway. Vehicles and loads shall not be parked on the highway at any time.
- The driver of the vehicle shall carry an approved copy of the permit **and supplemental notification form WEX CRA 110A** in the vehicle to which it applies and shall have it available for inspections by any police officer, Motor Carrier Officer or duly authorized Road Commission employee.
- Applicant shall be responsible for any damage caused to wires, mailboxes, trees, buildings, or the road, including the structures and appurtenances, and shall reimburse the appropriate parties for any damage caused by the moving of said vehicle or load. Applicant shall save harmless, indemnify, defend, and represent the Road against any and all claims for bodily injury or property damage, or any other claim arising out of a related to the moving of said vehicle, load, or its presence on or use of the highway by said vehicle and load. In addition to any other liability or obligation that may otherwise exist, the Permit Holder, to the fullest extent permitted by law, shall indemnify and hold harmless the Road Commission and its agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses, and expenses including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees, arising out of or resulting from the performance of the work performed including claims, damages, losses, and expenses attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to injury to or destruction of tangible property, but only to the extent caused by the fault, negligent acts, or omissions of the Permit Holder, a Subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them, or anyone for whose acts they may be liable, regardless of whether or not such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by the parties indemnified hereunder. This obligation does not include an obligation to indemnify the parties indemnified hereunder for their sole negligence and shall not be construed to negate or modify other rights or obligations of indemnity that otherwise exist as to the parties or persons described herein.
- The Applicant shall furnish proof of general liability insurance in amounts not less than \$2,000,000 each occurrence and general aggregate, proof of automobile liability in amounts not less than \$2,000,000 combined single limit for each accident, bodily injury per accident, and property damage per accident, and in an amount not less than \$500,000 for bodily injury per person. Applicant shall cause the Road Commission to be an additional insured party on the policy. Such insurance shall cover a period not less than the term of the permit and shall provide that it cannot be cancelled without 30 days advance written notice to the Road Commission, be certified mail, first-class, return receipt requested. Permits are not valid if insurance expires. Insurance coverage shall remain in full force and effect while operating on the public highways under special permit.
- Applicant shall name the Road Commission as additional insured and certificate holder, by name, on any general comprehensive liability insurance or commercial general liability insurance carried by the applicant worded as follows: "The Board of Wexford County Road Commission, The Wexford County Road Commission, and their officers, agents and employees, are named as additional insured parties."
- Permit not valid unless accompanied by supplemental notification form WEX CRA 110A.**

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NOTIFICATION APPLICATION FOR REQUEST TO TRAVEL ON COUNTY ROADS DURING SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS FOR NONEMERGENCY PUBLIC UTILITY WORK

In compliance with MCLA §257.722, the following information is required to be submitted in writing by the public utility company requesting to transport legal weight loads on a county road during seasonal weight restrictions.

Applicant shall provide notification to the Road Commission, using a notification application provided by the Road Commission, when requesting access to operate on restricted roads. Applicant shall provide notification to the Road Commission, via facsimile or electronically, not later than 24 hours before the time of intended travel. For weekends or holidays Notification Applications shall be electronically, not later than 24 hours before the time of intended travel. For weekends or holidays Notification Applications shall be submitted to the Road Commission not later than 12:00 p.m. on the last business day immediately preceding the day of intended travel. If the Road Commission determines that the condition of a particular road under its jurisdiction makes it unusable, the Road Commission may deny access to all or any part of that road. The denial shall be made and communicated via facsimile or electronically to the Applicant within 24 hours after receiving notification that the public utility intends to perform nonemergency work that requires use of the road. Any notification that is not disapproved within 24 hours after the notice is received by the Road Commission is considered approved.

Approval of this Notification Application grants the Applicant only those rights specifically stated and no other. Additional work activities within the county road right-of-way may require a separate permit from the Road Commission. The road Commission makes no warranty either expressed or implied as to the condition or suitability of the road or roads requested for use. Any Permit Holder who conducts operations in a manner detrimental to the Road Commission's ability to maintain roads reasonably safe and convenient for public travel will be required to cease all such operations. If the road or roads are damaged, as determined by the Road Commission, due to the Permit Holder's operations, the Permit Holder shall be responsible for the cost of restoring the road or roads to a condition acceptable to the Road Commission. The Road Commission in its sole discretion may restore or contract for the restoration of the road or roads or authorize the Permit Holder to restore the road or roads.
